Managed File Transfer with FTPS (SSL/TLS), SFTP (SSH), and HTTPS.



Requirements

Software Clients	To connect to the New York State DMV (NYS DMV) Managed File Transfer (MFT) server, software clients must be able to support FTPS (SSL/TLS) or SFTP (SSH) protocols.

Protocols	<p><i>FTPS</i>: Users can select either Implicit (port 990) or Explicit (port 21) FTPS.</p> <p><i>SFTP</i>: Secure Shell (SSH) connections require connectivity over port 22.</p> <p><i>HTTPS</i>: Connections require a web browser that can connect to the site https://mft.dmv.state.ny.us over port 443.</p>
Transfers	The speed of a file transfer depends on many factors including internet connection speeds and file size.
Username And Password	To connect to the NYS DMV MFT server you must use a username and password that has been issued to you by the NYS DMV. Anonymous access is not allowed.
File Folders	<p>To transfer data to the NYS DMV, you must place data in the specified directory that is supplied to you.</p> <p>To receive data from the NYS DMV, you must retrieve data from the specified directory that is supplied to you.</p>
Connectivity	Users must have an internet connection.
